Cox declared a quorum established with 38 Delegates, 20 would be needed for a majority and 26 needed for a supermajority of 2/3 and stated "I hereby retain the right to re-establish the quorum as determined necessary." President Cox also made an announcement that some votes would be considered unanimously approved as long as there was no dissent from the Delegates.

The meeting's agenda was adopted with no dissent.

The rules of debate were adopted with no dissent.

President Cox stated that a new quorum had been established per the roll call. 33 delegates, which need 17 for a majority and 22 for a supermajority. Bylaws need a supermajority to pass.

Becca Caufman (PA) – Chair of the Policy Committee thanked its members and explained how each bylaw amendment vote would happen. Each vote will be preceded by a statement from the Policy Committee and its recommendation.

John Combe (OR) – requested clarification on the total tally of eligible voters. Cox stated that additional people had joined the meeting, 37 at this point.

Barbara Lis (IN)- requested clarification on the change in majority and supermajority to pass. Cox restated that there were 37 delegates voting, therefore 19 were needed for majority, 25 for supermajority.

Kimberly Hodge (TN) asked how we are determining abstentions. Cox stated that by not voting either for or against an item it constitutes an abstention.

Becca Caufman (PA) stated that the Policy Committee recommends adoption.

John Combe (OR) stated the OR BOMT rationale in submitting this resolution.

Paul Andrews (MA) asked if this will be on-demand or online? Cox stated that the training will be online. John Combe (OR) Moved to adopt.

Barbara Lis (IN) – Thanked the OR board and agrees.

Elections

Presentation of Slate of Candidates

Cox presented the slate of candidates to the Delegate Assembly. Cox stated that there will be voting by declaration by acclimation, which barring any dissent automatically affirms the vote.

Position 1: Craig Knowles (GA) running unopposed, affirmed by acclimation.

Position 2: Victoria Drago (FL) running unopposed, affirmed by acclimation.

Cox stated that 19 votes were needed to confirm the winner, in the event that neither candidate gets a majority, another vote would be taken.

Position 3: Diane Layden (NC) running for open position, Foad Araiinejad (AL) running for open position.



Election results:

Craig Knowles (GA) and Victoria Drago (FL) both retained their seats on the Board. Foad Araiinejad (AL) was elected to the open board position.

Nominations: 2022 Nominating Committee

All three candidates were elected to the nominating committee with no dissent from the delegates. Carla Hedtke (WI), Kimberly Hodge (TN), Megan Maxey (WA)
